Admission to Honours To enter Honours Mathematics, students must have **either**:

- Completed a Mathematics Major in the Science program, including at least **30** units of credit in Level III Mathematics; **or**
- Completed Stage 3 of one of the Mathematics plans in the Advanced Science program

In addition, students will normally be required to have a credit average ($\geq 65\%$ weighted average mark; WAM) **in their Level III Mathematics courses** and to have shown some evidence of the ability to undertake independent study. To obtain this permission, you should, as early as possible, consult with the appropriate Departmental Honours Coordinator:

- Pure Mathematics - Dr Hendrik Grundling (Room 5104)
- Statistics – Dr. Yanan Fan (Room 2055)
