The School of Mathematics & Statistics Scholarship - UGCA1108

Value: \$5000/year (available for up to 4 years)

Candidates: High School leavers

Applications open: Late June **Closing date:** Late September

For commencement in the following year Semester 1

Selection: Targeted to students with an ATAR of at least 98 and a Mathematics Extension 1 and 2 total of at least 190.

School of Mathematics & Statistics Teachers Scholarship - UGCA1109

Value: \$5000/year (available for up to 4 years)

Candidates: High School leavers

Applications open: Late June **Closing date:** Late September

For commencement in the following year Semester 1

Selection: The Scholarship is established to encourage students to pursue a career in teaching Mathematics upon completion of their program of study.

The School of Mathematics & Statistics Rural Scholarship - UGCE1079

Value: \$5000/year (available for up to 4 years)

Candidates: High School leavers

Applications open: Late June **Closing date:** Late September

For commencement in the following year Semester 1

Selection: Targeted to rural students, who must have achieved an ATAR of at least 95 and a Mathematics Extension 1 and 2 total of at least 185.

The Late Jim & Alma Douglas Scholarship - UGCA1205

Value: \$6000/year for duration of program. One scholarship available

Candidates: High School leavers

Applications open: Late July **Closing date:** Late September

For commencement in the following year Semester 1

Selection: The Scholarship aims to encourage students to undertake study in the School of Mathematics and Statistics with a major/study plan in Mathematics and/or Statistics

Applicants will be assessed on the basis of: •Academic merit •Mathematics (Mathematics Extension I and II) and English results

Recipients of this scholarship are expected to maintain an overall Weighted Average Mark (WAM) and a Mathematics/Statistics subjects WAM of at least 75 (DISTINCTION) with no failed subjects in order to be considered eligible for renewal.

Women in Mathematics & Statistics Scholarship - UGCE1098

Value: \$5000/year (available for up to 4 years). One scholarship available

Candidates: High School leavers

Applications open: Late June **Closing date:** Late September

For commencement in the following year Semester 1

Applicants will be assessed on the basis of: • Academic merit • Mathematics (Extension I and II) and have achieved at least 185

Consideration will also be given to potential to contribute to and participate in the life of the School of Mathematics and Statistics, particularly through involvement in the “Women in Mathematics and Statistics” program. Other areas of contribution may include involvement in such activities as the Student Mathematical Society (MathSoc) or mentoring other students.

School of Mathematics and Statistics Indigenous Scholarship - UGCE1268

Value: \$5000/year (available for up to 4 years). One scholarship available

Candidates: High School leavers

Applications open: Early July **Closing date:** Late November.

For commencement in the following year Semester 1

The Scholarship aims to encourage and support Indigenous Australian students to undertake study in UNSW’s School of Mathematics and Statistics

Applicants will be assessed on the basis of:

- Be an Australian Indigenous student who is of Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander descent, and identifies as an Aboriginal or Torres Strait Islander
- Proposing to or enrolled in their 1st year of a full-time in a Bachelor of Science (single or dual) majoring in Mathematics or Statistics
- Academic merit
- Reasons for undertaking the proposed program of study
- Preference may be given to applicants in receipt of means-tested Centrelink Benefits, such as ABSTUDY, Youth Allowance, or Austudy

The Beautiful Mind Scholarship - UGCA1392

Value: \$5000/year (available for duration of Program). Up to two awarded (one to a female and one to a male)

Candidates: High School leavers

Applications open: Late July **Closing date:** Late September.

For commencement in the following year Semester 1

The Scholarship aims to encourage and assist students to undertake study in the School of Mathematics and Statistics at UNSW

Applicants will be assessed on the basis of: • Academic merit • Mathematics (HSC Mathematics courses and School of Mathematics Statistics annual Mathematics Competition results in the year prior to the awarding of the Scholarship) • Consideration will also be given to applicants who were members of the Mathematical Olympiad.
