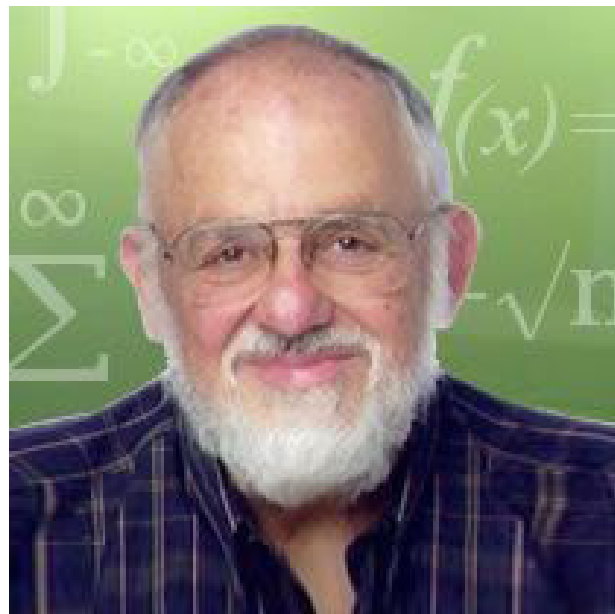


Origins of MATLAB

MATLAB is now a full-featured technical computing environment, but it started as a simple “Matrix Laboratory.”

Three individuals, J. H. Wilkinson, George Forsythe, and John Todd, played important roles in the origins of MATLAB.

Cleve’s account begins more than 50 years ago.

Cleve Moler is chief mathematician, chairman, and cofounder of MathWorks. Moler was a professor of math and computer science for almost 20 years at the University of Michigan, Stanford University, and the University of New Mexico.
